I had a little time with nothing to do so I thought I'd write to you. Did you get the pictures? I sent them two weeks ago.

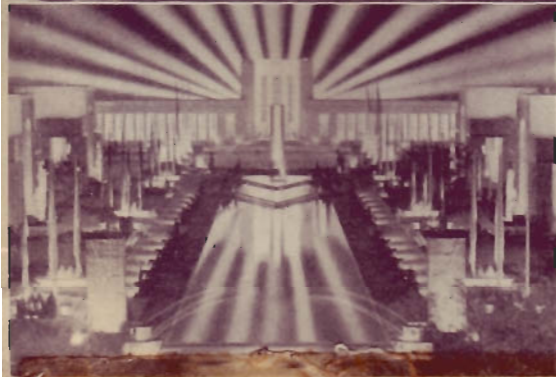

There has been a lot of mail lost here.

They have cut short all of our laundry and all other credits. They issued all of our winter clothing too. Don't know where our new ones are being sent. Write soon!
