FORT BRAGG, N. C.

April 18, 1942

Go. This is a hurried letter just to let you know I'm back again at Bragg. I had hard luck with the trains most of the way. All of them being late arriving at the destination several hours late, therefore I would miss the trains and would have to stop over until the next train.

I had eleven hours in Washington D. C. again missing the morning train by minutes. Another soldier and I took the town in, but I will tell you about that later.

Incidentally I arrived this morning (Sat) at four A.M.

Making me two days late.

commander, and I'm to have  
another chance. It seems that  
I'm finally starting get a break  
now and then.

I'll write again either  
tonite or tomorrow, but I want
