

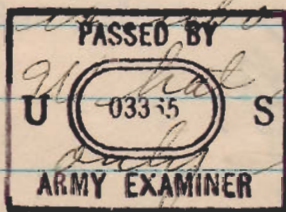

about me.

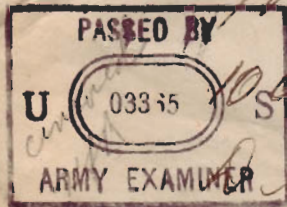
